

After Breast Biopsy: At-Home Instructions

- 1. Do not participate in strenuous exercise or activity for the rest of the day. Wait until the next morning.
- 2. Leave the pressure dressing in place until the next morning. At that time, it may be removed and you may shower or bathe as usual.
- 3. Place an ice pack over the dressing if there is discomfort or bleeding after the biopsy. You may take a non-aspirin pain reliever such as Tylenol[®].
- 4. If there is any bleeding from the biopsy site, apply firm pressure with 2 fingers over the bandage.
- 5. If you have moderate to severe bleeding or pain after your biopsy, contact the Breast Clinic at 716-845-3152. The clinic is open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. After hours, call 716-845-2300 or toll free at 1-800-ROSWELL (1-800-767-9355) and our Call Center or nurse triage staff will assist you. If it is determined you need to be seen, you may be asked to come to our Assessment & Treatment Center (ATC), which is open 24/7. You need to be referred to the ATC by your Roswell Park provider (or the provider on-call); it is not a walk-in clinic.
